Because of the language versions (the partners' language), the Library comprises 156 e-books (144 which are the 24 books in 6 language versions plus 12 books in the original language spoken by the immigrants involved in the project). The Library will be an open education resource (OER) available on the project website.

The stories contained in the books will reflect elements of the culture of each country. There are two children's stories per country: one represents a traditional story, one the most popular in the country and the other is a contemporary story written within the project. Each story is in the original languages and translated into the other partners' languages. Thus, as explained above, the Library comprises 6 language versions of the 24 e-books and 12 e-books in the immigrants' language. This unique OER is downloadable free from the MultiLib project website.

At the kick-off meeting the partners will have already identified the primary schools and the groups of migrants to work with. These will have been reached through the schools (i.e. students', parents) or through local associations working with immigrants.

Criteria and guidelines for the stories and to work with the target groups will be agreed. Meetings for cultural exchange with the group of immigrants involved will follow. Once the stories will have been written, the partners will contact picture artists. The Library will be an Open Education Resource (OER) on the project website. The lead partner will supervise the Output action plan.

Following the creation of the library, at the second partnership meeting, the partners will agree on the guidelines for the creation of the book-based children's activities. Each partner will contribute to the realization of the activity set. The lead partners will supervise.

#### **OUTPUT 3: MULTILIB TEACHER GUIDE**

The MultiLib Teachers Guide will be a valuable source for teachers to work with the Children's Activity Set, but also to find their own reasons and expand ways to work continuously on the topics of inclusiveness, multicultural and multilingual experiences, love of reading and embedding the arts into education.

Once Output 1 and 2 (The MultiLib Library and MultiLib Children's Activity Set) will be ready, the partners will discuss on criteria and rules of participation to invite the global community to share additional children's stories and children's activities to the project.

P6 (TUC), P1 (Viksjöfors school) and P2 (Mosaic) will prepare the Templates, in February 2018, to be filled by those who will want to share new stories or activities. These will be reviewed by the partners and prepared for the website.

Each additional item, complied on the right template and sent to the project by anyone interested, will be reviewed by P1, P2 and P6, approved according to the agreed criteria, and uploaded on the project website.

This activity will contribute to the collaborative learning of project as a whole.

The partners will then be ready to create and organize local Teacher Training events to spread the resources to interested multipliers (E1-2-3-4-5-6).

An International Conference (E7) is envisaged in Brussels. The lead partner, the IYMF, has a long-term experience in the organization of conferences, round-tables, cultural events in Brussels, attended by authorities and policy-makers at European level. All partners will work on dissemination of the Conference. Parts of the Conference will be filmed and streamed on the project website for a global audience.



### **PROJECT SUMMARY**

Page 78 in Application

More than a million migrants and refugees crossed into Europe in 2015, sparking a crisis, as countries struggled to cope with the influx. Just to mention one country, Sweden, in 2015 received asylum applications in the ratio of 1667 per 100000 in proportion to its population (BBC news/world-europe-3413).

How to deal with not only migrants' immediate primary needs, but with integration into Europe schooling and labour market?

How to guarantee dignity and respect for mutual cultures?

MultiLib answers by taking into account the importance of children's education, since they herald future Europe.

Primary school teachers, who play a front-line role in education, need to acquire a broader repertoire of teaching strategy to tackle the challenge of teaching increasingly multi-ethnic and multilingual classes.


The project provides primary school teachers with high quality innovative didactic tools to equip for this task:

A Library which is a unique OER with 24 multilingual e-books in 6 language versions, plus 12 e-books in original languages of immigrants in Europe (translated in 6 languages). A total of 156 e-books beautifully illustrated by picture book artists and accompanied by a Set of book-based Activities for Children and a Teacher Guide.

Through the use of the resources, teachers enable primary school children, both from local and migrant background, to:

- Develop a sense of social inclusion
- Enhance intercultural understanding
- Make children from ethnic minorities, and particularly from newly arrived migrant families, proud to share their culture and language, and pleased to learn about others
- Acquire skills that will contribute to their future employment in a labour market increasingly requiring multicultural knowledge, mobility (therefore language skills) and get competences
- Enjoy collaborative educational activities with creativity and fun while enhancing love of reading, literacy, language and artistic skills.

Different types of partner organizations ensure that the project is implemented effectively and professionally. The consortium includes: primary school from Sweden, foundation with European network of primary schools from Belgium, language school from Czech Republic, art and education provider from the UK and universities from Greece and Turkey. All partners work with local primary schools and with group of immigrants.



All products will be embedded into the partner institutions didactic offerings as they respond to direct needs of the organizations involved but not less importantly they will be OER mainstreamed through networks of multipliers across Europe and beyond.

The uniqueness of the resources and the fact that they are OER with free download from the project website, plus a detailed, effective and innovative dissemination plan, guarantees a strong level of project sustainability.

The project ends with an International Conference on MultiLib and topics such as inclusiveness and multicultural approaches. This will be a major event featuring leaders in education and streamed on the project website.

#### IN SWEDISH

#### Snabböversättning av sammanfattningen i ansökan (med hjälp av Google Translate)

Mer än en miljon invandrare och flyktingar korsade i Europa 2015 och länderna kämpade för att klara tillströmningen. (T.ex. fick Sverige enligt BBC news / världen europa-3413, 2015 asylansökningar i förhållandet 1667 per 100000 invånare). Hur kan man hantera inte bara migranternas omedelbara primära behov, utan också integrationen i Europa vad gäller utbildning och arbetsmarknad? Hur garanterar vi värdighet och respekt för ömsesidiga kulturer?

Multilib svarar genom att ta hänsyn till vikten av barns utbildning, eftersom den förebådar det framtida Europa. Grundskolelärare, som finns i frontlinjen avi utbildningen, måste skaffa sig en bredare repertoar av undervisningsstrategier för att undervisa i multietniska och flerspråkiga klasser.

Projektet rustar grundskolelärare med innovativa didaktiska verktyg av hög kvalitet för denna uppgift:

Ett bibliotek som är en unik OER (öppen undervisningsresurs) med 24 flerspråkiga e-böcker i 6 språkversioner, plus 12 e-böcker på originalspråk för invandrare i Europa (översatt till 6 språk). Totalt 156 e-böcker, vackert illustrerade av bilderbokskonstnärer och åtföljda av en uppsättning aktiviteter för barn samt en lärarhandledning.

Genom att använda dessa resurser kan låg- och mellanstadielärare :

- Utveckla en känsla av social integration
- Öka interkulturell förståelse
- Göra barn från etniska minoriteter, och särskilt från nyanlända invandrarfamiljer, stolta över att dela sin kultur och språk, och glada över att lära sig om andra
- Förvärva kunskaper som bidrar till deras framtida anställning i en arbetsmarknad som alltmer kräver mångkulturell kunskap, mobilitet (därför språkkunskaper) och IT-kompetens
- Ha roligt och samtidigt stärka läslust, läskunnighet, språk och konstnärliga färdigheter.

Olika typer av partnerorganisationer ser till att projektet genomförs effektivt och professionellt. I konsortiet ingår: En grundskola i Sverige, ett europeiskt nätverk av grundskolor i Belgien, en språkskola i Tjeckien, en konst och utbildningsanordnare i Storbritannien samt två universitet i Grekland och Turkiet. Alla parter arbetar med lokala grundskolor och med invandrargrupper.

Det unika med de resurser och det faktum att de är OER, med gratis nedladdning från projektets webbplats, plus en detaljerad, effektiv och innovativ spridningsplan garanterar en stark nivå av projekt hållbarhet. Våren 2018 kommer projektet att spridas i Workshops i alla projektländer.

Projektet avslutas med en stor internationell konferens om Multilib, med ämnen som delaktighet och olika kulturer. Konferensen kommer att strömmas på projektets webbplats.
